Over 423 displaced families residing in Al-Faw site in Marib City District of Marib Governorate encountered significant challenges in obtaining water. Women and children were compelled to undertake lengthy daily journeys to collect water, resulting in health problems, accidents, and children discontinuing their education.

Elham Al-Faqih and her son Mohammad experienced ongoing hardship, as he had to abandon his education in order to fetch water. This situation left Ilham with insufficient time to manage her household, provide education for her children, attend to their health, and focus on personal growth.

During the work of BCFHD team in the project of managing displaced persons’ sites, they found out that providing water for drinking and using is the most important need for the IDPs. Therefore, BCFHD implemented a project to complete the rehabilitation of the water source located at Western Al-Faw site.

BCFHD rehabilitated the well, upgraded the pumping system, installed a modern pump, high-efficiency water transmission pipes, connection cables, and a protective cover for the well to ensure its safety.

Elham told us “Improving the water source has played a vital role in changing our lives. After securing a nearby and sufficient water source, I was able to send my son Mohammad back to school and accompany him there.

Now, Elham and all displaced individuals no longer have to travel long distances to obtain water or drop out of school. They can easily access sufficient quantities of water to drink and meet their daily needs without difficulty, leading to a significant improvement in their lives.
